




***Heart of America Council, 2017 Scouting “500”
September 22, 23 & 24, 2017
Scouting Staff, Volunteer & Vendor Information Guide
(Updated 8/27/2017)***

Registration:

ALL staff and volunteer participants will be required to register for The Scouting “500” in order to participate. The Pit Stop Director or Committee Chairperson in charge of each area will maintain the authorized list of registered Scouting Staff and Event Volunteers/Vendors with approved access to the Kansas Speedway. Staff packets will be available at the Kansas Speedway Credentials Center on Wednesday, September 20th 3:00 PM – 7:00 PM, Thursday, September 21st 1:00 PM – 8:00 PM, Friday, September 22nd from 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM and Saturday, September 23rd 6:00 AM – 5:00 PM.

The Kansas Speedway Credentials Center, located on France Family drive, accessed from Village West Parkway, across from Children’s Mercy Park/Sporting KC Soccer Complex. There you will check in, receive wrist bands, t-shirt(s), parking permit, and directions to your assigned area. Once you receive your wrist band, it will be valid for the entire event, and there is no need to check in again. Wrist bands must be worn at all times to obtain access to the track, and parking passes should be easily visible in your vehicles.

Credentials Center Location:



ALL VOLUNTEERS/VENDORS AND EVENT STAFF WILL BE REQUIRED TO OBTAIN CREDENTIALS & A PARKING PERMIT PRIOR TO GAINING ACCESS TO THE KANSAS SPEEDWAY. A PHOTO ID WILL BE REQUIRED.

Insurance Coverage:

The General Liability Insurance coverage provides primary general liability coverage for registered volunteer Scouters with respect to claims arising out of an official Scouting activity, such as the Scouting 500, with the exception that the coverage is excess over any insurance that may be available to the volunteer for loss arising from the ownership, maintenance, or use of a motor vehicle or watercraft. This insurance is available only while the vehicle or watercraft is in the actual use of a Scouting unit and being used for a Scouting purpose. Coverage is more than \$5 million for bodily injury and property damage.

The insurance provided to unregistered Scouting volunteers attending the Scouting 500 through the general liability insurance program is excess over any other insurance the volunteer might have to his or her benefit, usually a homeowners, personal liability, or auto liability policy.


The general liability policy does not provide indemnification or defense coverage to those individuals who commit intentional and/or criminal acts. The Boy Scouts of America does not have an insurance policy which provides defense for situations involving allegations of intentional and/or criminal acts.

The Heart of America Council holds an Accident and Sickness Insurance Policy for Scouts, Scouters and participants of the Scouting 500. This policy furnishes medical reimbursement in case of death, accident, or sickness within the policy amounts. This plan is an Excess Insurance Plan and will pay eligible expenses not paid by any other collectible insurance or pre-paid health plan in-force. Additional information regarding this policy is available through the Heart of America Council.

Arrival & Departure:

Arrivals and departures to and from the **Infield & Pit Road Display Area** will be via Village West Parkway to France Family Drive (across from Children's Mercy Park/Sporting KC Soccer Complex) through the tunnel to the Infield.

Arrivals and departures to and from the **Grandstand Display Areas** will be via Village West Parkway to France Family Drive (across from Children's Mercy Park/Sporting KC Soccer Complex), onto Daytona Drive to the assigned display area.



Set & Tear Down:

Set up is available Wednesday September 20th – Saturday September 23rd, or Monday & Tuesday with prior approval of your Pit Stop Director or Committee Chairman. We ask that as much of the program equipment, displays, cars, trucks etc. arrive and move to your assigned locations **between 8:00 AM and 3:00 PM on Friday September 22nd**. **All vehicle access in and out of the Infield will close on Friday at 5:00 PM**

For those who cannot arrive until Saturday September 23rd, access to the Infield Display Areas will be **available from 6:00 AM until 8:30 AM, at which time the France Family Drive tunnel and Daytona Drive will be closed to traffic**. Any arrivals after 8:30 AM must be approved by and coordinated with your Pit Stop Director.

Tear down and departures from the Infield are available on Saturday September 23rd between 5:30 PM and 7:00 PM, after 10:30 PM and Sunday September 24th between 6:30 AM & 11:30 AM. It is the responsibility of the Pit Stop Director, Committee Chairman and all volunteers/vendors, to ensure **All Areas Are Left Clean and Organized.**

One exception will be made for the Car and Truck display vehicles. There will be a 30 minute departure window on Saturday from 3:00 PM – 3:30 PM for those who need to leave early. We ask your patience with this process as it will be controlled and slow. Any need to deviate from these arrival or departure times must be approved by Ken Horrell (Program Chairman) & Rob Richardson (Transportation Chairman)

Meals:

Saturday meals will be provided for all Staff, Volunteers/Vendors except Car & Truck Clubs (see *Schedule of Events at the end of this guide for specifics*). Concession stands will also be open in the Infield with a variety of menu items, and of course all are welcome to bring in food and drinks, with the exception of grills and alcoholic drinks which are not permitted. Dress:

All registered/paid BSA Staff are asked to wear their Scouting “500” staff shirt. All other volunteers should wear Scouting, or your Company/Organization attire. Rain gear and a jacket are also strongly recommended – **BE PREPARED!**

Parking:

A limited amount of staff/volunteer/vendor parking spaces will be available in the Speedway Infield. Parking Permits and locations will be assigned by the Pit Stop Directors and Committee Chairmen. General staff parking will be available on the Northwest side of the Speedway, close to Children’s Mercy Park (Sporting KC), with access to the Infield via Grandstand Entry Gate B.

Blue Parking Permits – General Staff Parking, Blue Parking Area #9 outside of the Infield, Northwest side of the Speedway, close to Children’s Mercy Park (Sporting KC)

White #1 Parking Permits – Vendor/Staff Lot #1, fenced parking inside the Infield. See map for location

White #2 Parking Permits – Vendor/Staff Lot #2 inside the Infield. Trailer parking available, see map for location

Pink Parking Permits – ALL ACCESS

Cost:

BSA/HOAC registered Scouters must register via www.Scouting500.org or [Text STAFF500 To 51555](Text). The cost is \$15.00 and includes a Staff T-Shirt (additional shirt can be purchased for \$10.00 during the registration process or purchased at the Credentials center at check in), Staff Event Patch and 3 meals on Saturday.

There is no cost for non-scout Vendor/ Volunteer participation. We appreciate your support of the Heart of America Council Scouting Program! Your meals are not included, but concessions are available for purchase throughout the Infield and you're welcome to bring in food and drinks, with the exception of grills and alcoholic drinks which are not permitted.

Camping:

Camping for Staff, Exploring Posts, and Out of Council Units is available in the [BLUE AREA](#), located off Daytona Dr., across from Grandstand Entry Gate A on the Northwest side of the Speedway (see camping map). Jr. Staff must camp with their respective Units, adhering to the rules and policies of BSA.

Tent camping will be available in the [BLUE AREA](#), located off Daytona Dr., across from Grandstand Entry Gate A on the Northwest side of the Speedway (see camping map). Porta Potties will be provided, but no water or electricity is available.

RV's and Campers will be allowed for adult Staff volunteers (over the age of 21). RV/Camper camping will be on the Turn 4 Motorhome Terrace, located off Daytona Drive just before the Grandstand. RV spots are limited and will be assigned by your Pit Stop Director or Committee Chairman on a first come basis. **No hook ups are available.**

There are no hook ups in the tent camping area, but Porta Potties will be available.

Staff Check-In & Speedway Access

All HOAC/Volunteer/Vendor Staff must be registered prior to the event. Pit Stop Directors and Committee Chairman be responsible for their staff/volunteers/vendors. Staff Check-In & Speedway Access (continued)

Once registered, either in the HOAC registration system or directly with your Pit Stop/Committee Chairman, a Staff/Volunteer/Vendor packet will be provided. This packet will contain

- Wrist Band
- T-shirt(s)
- Parking Pass
- Map

Staff packets will be available at the **Kansas Speedway Credentials Center** on Wednesday, September 20th from 3:00 PM – 7:00 PM, Thursday, September 21st from 1:00 PM – 8:00 PM, Friday, September 22nd from 8:00 AM – 8:00 PM and Saturday, September 23rd 6:00 AM – 5:00 PM.

The **Kansas Speedway Credentials Center**, located on France Family drive, accessed from Village West Parkway, across from Children's Mercy Park/Sporting KC Soccer Complex. There you will check in, receive wrist bands, t-shirt(s), parking permit, and directions to your assigned area. Once you receive your wrist band, it will be valid for the entire event, and there is no need to check in again. **Wrist Bands must be worn at all times** to obtain access to the track, and parking passes should be easily visible in your vehicles. **Wrist bands for commissioners registered to work sub-camp will be available at the Green Sub-camp HQ after 9:00 AM Friday, September 22, 2017.**

Infield access/parking will be available Friday from 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM. If you have parked in the Infield staff parking area, you will need to get your car out by 4:30 PM if you wish to leave prior to the end of "Friday Night Lights" programming at 10:00 PM. Please move to the Blue Parking Area #9 outside of the Infield, located off Daytona Drive on the Northwest side of the Speedway, close to Children's Mercy Park/Sporting KC Soccer Complex. Access to the Infield is via Grandstand Entry Gate B. Set up can continue until 10:30 PM, at which time the France Family Drive tunnel will reopen for vehicles to exit the track. Vehicles can be left in the Staff parking area overnight.

On Saturday morning, the Infield staff parking area will be open from 6:00 AM until 8:30 AM and not reopen to traffic until 5:30 PM. If you need to leave before 5:30 PM, or arrive after 8:30 AM, please park in the Blue Parking Area #9 outside of the Infield, located off Daytona Drive on the Northwest side of the Speedway, close to Children's Mercy Park/Sporting KC Soccer Complex Sporting KC, with access to the Infield via Grandstand Entry Gate B.

On Sunday, the Infield Tunnel will be open from 6:30 AM to 11:30 AM to allow for tear down and exiting the Kansas Speedway Infield. ***Please be advised, Richard Petty Driving Experience will running Ride a Long's, so the track will be secured and in use. All activity must remain behind the fences and walls separating the Infield from the track.***

Commitment:

- All Staff members will be **expected to work a minimum 8 hours** during The Scouting “500”
- Adult Staff may be working with and/or supervising Scouts under the age of 18, so Youth Protection is required 2 Deep Leadership policies will be in effect.

Age:

- All BSA registered adults serving on staff must be over the age of 18 and have Youth Protection Training.
- BSA registered Scouts, age 15, 16 & 17, can serve on Jr. Staff under the following conditions:
 - ✓ The Program Director or Committee Chairman in charge of each area, accepts responsibility for the Jr. Staff they recruit.
 - ✓ Jr. Staff must be assigned to work with an adult over the age of 21.
 - ✓ Adults supervising Jr. Staff must either be the parent of the Jr. Staff person or a registered leader with BSA and have Youth Protection training.
 - ✓ Two deep leadership applies in all cases.

Arrival & Departure Procedure

If you'd like to avoid the congestion on Saturday morning, vehicles for display at the "500" and be brought to Speedway on Friday before 4:30 PM and left overnight in the assigned fenced display area. Security will be provided. **All Friday arrivals must be prearranged, including approximate arrival time, with Dave Belzer, Pit Stop Director for the Midway - (816) 838-6490 (d.belzer@sbcglobal.net)**

Friday September 22nd

- Check in will be from the Kansas Speedway Credentials Building located on France Family Drive accessed from Village West Parkway, across from Children's Mercy Park from 8:00 AM until 8:00 PM. Registration staff will check you in and assist with directions and parking. Name, address, phone number, license plate number and a photo ID will be required to check in.

Recognizing not everyone will be able to arrive on Friday and leave vehicles overnight, below is the procedure for arriving and departing on Saturday September 23rd.

Saturday September 23rd

- Arrival times 6:00 AM – 8:00 AM
- Check – In & Staging Area
 - ✓ From State Street or Village West Parkway, turn west (towards the track) on Homestead-Miami Drive.
 - ✓ Proceed on Homestead-Miami Drive and our staff will line you up in the order of arrival. Scouting "500" Staff will handle check in and distribute your credentials for access to the track. Name, address, phone number, license plate number and a photo ID will be required to check in.
 - ✓ After staging and check in, our staff will direct you to the designated display area.

PLEASE EXERCISE CAUTION AND SLOW SPEEDS AS THERE WILL BE SCOUTS AND STAFF WORKING IN THE INFIELD. VEHICLES ARE NOT ALLOWED ON THE RACING SURFACE AT ANY TIME!

- **No vehicles will be allowed on the track at any time.** Designated parking & display areas have been assigned
- Departure times 3:00 PM – 3:30 PM or 5:30 PM – 7:00 PM (see below for details)
- No vehicles will be allowed to leave the Kansas Speedway Infield prior to 3:00 PM due to safety concerns, except for an emergency or if approved prior to the event.
- 3:00 PM – In order to allow for the safe and orderly departure of vehicles from Pit Road, we will open the infield tunnel on France Family Drive between 3:00 PM – 3:30 PM. We encourage ALL participants to stay until the end of day programming at 5:00 PM, but recognize the need of some participants to depart early.
- 5:30 PM – **All vehicles must depart between 5:30 PM and 7:00 PM or remain until 10:00 PM.**
 - ✓ Parking is available outside of the Infield for those who want to come back to the grandstand and enjoy the Saturday evening stage show.

Military, Emergency Response Vehicles, Trucks, Heavy Equipment & Non-Automobile Vehicle Displays Arrival & Departure Procedure

We encourage as many of the Trucks, Military, Emergency Response Vehicles, Heavy Equipment & Non-Automobile vehicles and individuals as possible bring your vehicles for display at the "500", to arrive on Friday before 5:00 PM and leave your vehicles overnight in the assigned display area. Security will be provided.

All Friday arrivals must be prearranged, with your Program Director, Ashley Lorenc

Friday September 22nd

- Check in will be from the Kansas Speedway Credentials Building located on France Family Drive accessed from Village West Parkway, across from Children's Mercy Park from 8:00 AM until 8:00 PM. Registration staff will check you in and assist with directions and parking.

 - ✓ After check in, our staff will direct you to your assigned Display Area.
 - ✓ **PLEASE EXERCISE CAUTION AND SLOW SPEEDS AS THERE WILL BE SCOUTS AND STAFF IN THE AREA**
- Departure times 5:30 PM or 10:30 PM. We encourage all participants to stay until the end of day programming at 10:00 PM, but recognize the need to depart early.
- No vehicles will be allowed to leave the Kansas Speedway prior to 5:30 PM due to safety concerns, except for an emergency or if approved prior to the event.
 - ✓ **Vehicles may depart between 5:30 PM and 7:00 PM or after 10:30 PM**
 - ✓ Parking is available outside of the Infield for those who want to come back to the grandstand and enjoy the Saturday evening stage show.




